

Chelmsford Friends of Music (CFoM) College Scholarship Application & Information

General Information

College Scholarships are awarded to CHS graduating seniors who will be attending a 4-year or 2-year institution and plan to Major or Minor in Music in college.

1. Scholarships are awarded each year at the CHS Spring Pops Concert. Those not in attendance will be notified individually. Should there be no Spring Pops Concert, alternative means of award will be implemented.
2. The number and value of the awards will be based upon the availability of funds and number of applicants.
3. All decisions of the CFoM Scholarship Committee will be final.

Eligibility Requirements

1. The applicant must be currently enrolled in the Chelmsford Public School System and be an active member in one of the **graded** performance band, chorus or orchestra programs offered by the Chelmsford School System.
2. Under normal circumstances, the applicant must have performed a minimum of 10 hours of documented volunteer service to CFoM prior to the date of application. **For this year only, we will consider applicants who have ANY CFoM service hours.** If you have no CFoM service hours, please contact us prior to applying. 3. The application and all documents are **due by Monday, May 10, 2021** to be eligible for consideration.

1. Completed application form. Please type or print all information where possible.

2. A copy of your college, university or conservatory acceptance letter.
 - For music majors, the letter must indicate that the applicant is enrolled in a 4-year program as a defined music major.
 - For music minors, the applicant must be enrolled in a 2-year or 4-year program in which they intend to continue their music education as a Music Minor.

3. A personal letter, written in your own words, describing your musical interests and goals and how this scholarship will help you achieve those goals. Sign and date the letter. Please type or print only.
4. A copy of your CHS Secondary School Record (resume), which details your in-school and out-of-school activities.
5. A CFoM Music Educator Recommendation Form (see Appendix A).
 - Student must complete the top portion of the Music Education Recommendation Form and deliver it to a music educator for completion. Please be considerate and give your music educator ample time to complete your form.
